

## **REPORT OF CME ON 'OVERVIEW OF CERVICAL LESIONS AND MANAGEMENT GUIDELINES' ON 10<sup>TH</sup> APRIL, 2018 AT HAMDARD CONVENTION CENTRE, JAMIA HAMDARD**

The department of Obstetrics and Gynecology, HIMSR and SUMER had jointly organized CME on '**Overview of Cervical Lesions & Management Guidelines**' on 10<sup>th</sup> April, 2018 at Hamdard Convention Centre from 9-4 PM. The CME was done under the aegis of Indian Society of Colposcopy and Cervical Pathology (ISCCP). It was attended by approximately 250 delegates apart from the invited faculty and organizing committee (50 in number). Delegates from the various Institutes of Delhi, Noida and Ghaziabad attended it.
