

CAESARIAN SECTION IN MEDICAL ICU

A 28 yr old female patient (G2 A1) was brought to the hospital with 35 weeks of gestation, severe dehydration and collapse at 0415 hrs . The patient was on anti depressant medication for the last three yrs.

On admission she was severely dehydrated and her general condition was poor and she was immediately admitted to MICU and given life supportive measures. At 0645 hrs she had a cardiac arrest and had to be put on ventilator. Also, simultaneously the fetus started showing signs of fetal distress.

Case was discussed between Anaesthesia and Gynaecology teams and an urgent Caesarian section was undertaken in the MICU itself. At 07:45 hrs. a live female child was delivered. Baby showed signs of hypoxia and had to be intubated and revived.

Currently both mother and child are surviving though critical.

Surgery was performed by Gynaecologist S.R Dr. Tabassum and anaesthesia was given by Senior Resident Dr. Mudassir. Medical aid and mother care was provided by Medical Unit-I Senior Resident Dr. Shamim and new born is being looked after by Dr. Chandra Mohan Kumar.
